WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri S LAKSHMI KANTH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action on the part of the Respondent No.2, 3, 4 and 5 in intending to grant permissions in favour of Respondent No.6 and 7 for establishing Petroleum Retail Outlet at Rangapur Village Cross Roads, Bommalaramaram, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District, disregarding Petitioner's representations dated 30.01.2026, contrary to guidelines of Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH), Indian Road Congress (IRC), and Central

Pollution Control Board (CPCB) as arbitrary, illegal and unjust, violative of Article 14, 19(1)(g) and Article 21 of Constitution of India and to consequently direct the Respondent No.2, 3, 4 and 5 not to issue permission for the proposed BPCL Retail Outlet.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and AFFIDAVIT filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. S LAKSHMI KANTH Advocate for the Petitioner and M/s. Pillix Law Firm, Counsel for respondent No.6, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.7 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
