Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ, Orders or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the 3rd Respondent in not considering the representation dated. 07/04/2026 in respect of Agriculture land in survey no.74/A/1 admeasuring to an extent of Ac. 01.25 guntas situated at Kondapur kalan village, Darur Mandal, Vikarabad District, as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to law and unconstitutional and consequently direct the 3rd Respondent to consider the representation dated.07/04/2026 by enquiring and not to do the any registrations relating to Agriculture land in survey no.74/A/1 admeasuring. to an extent of Ac. 01.25 guntas situated at Kondapur kalan village, Darur Mandal, Vikarabad District.

ORDER :

With the consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal at the stage of admission.

2. Aggrieved by the action of respondent No.3 in not considering the petitioner's representation dated 07.04.2026, the present Writ Petition is filed.

3. Heard Sri G. Manoj Goud, learned counsel for the petitioner and Ms. S. Sravanthi, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration, appearing for the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the mother of minor child Kumari Kurva Brinda, who is the granddaughter and lawful heir of late Kurva Beemaiah, and that she derives her right, title and interest in respect of the agricultural land in Sy.No.74/A/1, admeasuring Ac. 01.25 guntas, situated at Kondapur Kalan Village, Darur Mandal, Vikarabad District, by way of succession through her father-Kurva Ashok. Hence, the petitioner's daughter has a legitimate and enforceable share in the said property. It is further submitted that the petitioner apprehends illegal interference and unauthorized transactions in respect of the subject property. Therefore, the petitioner submitted a representation to respondent No.3 on 07.04.2026 requesting that no document relating to the subject property be registered without the prior written consent of the petitioner, who is the natural guardian of the minor child Kumari Kurva Brinda. However, no action has been taken by respondent No.3 so far. Therefore, learned counsel prays this Court to direct respondent No.3 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 07.04.2026 and pass appropriate orders in terms of

Section 8 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956, within a time-frame stipulated by this Court.

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader appearing for the respondents fairly submits that respondent No.3 will consider the representation dated 07.04.2026 submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

6. Having regard to the submissions made by learned counsel for the respective parties, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing respondent No.3 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 07.04.2026 in terms of Section 8 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956, and pass appropriate orders, strictly in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two (2) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate a copy of the decision to the petitioner.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

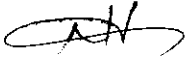

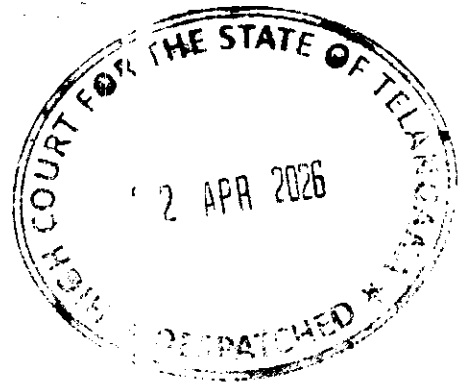
