Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one like Writ of Mandamus Declaring the action of the respondent Nos.3 to 7 in high handedly, arbitrarily and illegally trying to recover the amounts from the petitioner by not following Circular dated 12.08.2022 vide RBI/2022-23/108, DOR.ORG.REC.65/ 21.04.158/2022-23 issued by respondent no.2 or any due process of law and the inaction of the respondent no.2 to legitimately protect the interest of the petitioner by duly enforcing Circular dated 12.08.2022 vide RBI/ 2022-23/108, OR.ORG.REC.65/21.04.158/2022-23 as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional for violating Art 14, 19, and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently Direct the respondent no.2 to duly enforce the Circular dated 12.08.2022 vide RBI/2022-23/108, DOR.ORG. REC.65/ 21.04.158/2022-2 to protect the interests of the petitioner against the respondent nos.3 to 12.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent nos. 3 to 12 not to take any coercive measures against the petitioner without following due process of law and mandatorily following Circular dated 12.08.2022 vide R31/2022-23/108, DOR. ORDER:

Sri G. Venkat Ratnam Goud, learned counsel for the petitioner and Smt. NVR. Rajyalakshmi, learned Standing Counsel for Central Government representing Sri N. Bhujanga Rao, learned Deputy Solicitor General of India, for respondent No.1.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for petitioner submitted that the issue raised in this Writ Petition is squarely covered by the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.18913 of 2024, dated 22.08.2024 and therefore, the same order may be passed in this writ petition as well. The operative portion of the said order reads as under:

“8. In view of the above circulars, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to ensure that the agents engaged by them for recovery of the loan amounts, shall strictly follow the guidelines and instructions issued by the Reserve



Bank of India and also the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **ICICI Bank Ltd Vs. Prakash Kaur's** case (1 supra) and **ICICI Bank Vs. Shanti Devi Sharma's** case (2 supra).

9. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs."

3. Learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.1 has no objection.
4. Accordingly, in terms of the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.18913 of 2024, dated 22.08.2024, and for the reasons alike, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondent authorities and their agents to scrupulously follow the guidelines/instructions issued by the Reserve Bank of India in its Circular dated 12.08.2022 and also the judgments of Hon'ble Supreme Court in **ICICI Bank Ltd. v. Prakash Kaur's** case and **ICICI Bank v. Shanti Devi Sharma's** case, while recovering the loan amounts from the petitioner. No costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.
