WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. J. RAGHURAM presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS to declare the action of the Respondent No.2 herein in interfering with the civil disputes between the Petitioner and Respondent No.3 herein by frequently calling the Petitioner to the Police Station and making him to sit in the Police Station from morning to evening and trying to settle the civil disputes is illegal, arbitrary, violation Principles of Natural Justice and against the Article 14, 19, 21 and 300 (A) of the Constitution of India and Consequently direct the Respondent No.2 herein not to interfere with the civil disputes between the Petitioner and Respondent No.3 herein;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri J. RAGHURAM, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

ORDER:**

Respondent No.2 - the Station House Officer, Hayath Nagar Police Station, Hayath Nagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, is directed not to interfere in civil disputes pending between the petitioner and respondent No.3 without following due process of law.

Issue notice to respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.3 under registered post with acknowledgement due and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.
