In the meantime, the impugned order dated 31.01.2026 passed by the learned Principal Family Court, City Civil Courts Complex at Secunderabad in M.P.No.341 of 2025 in M.C.No.49 of 2025, shall stand suspended, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall pay an amount of Rs.25,000/- per month to respondent No.2 and Rs.30,000/- per month to respondent No.3 on or before the 10th day of every month and shall also pay 50% of the arrears on the very same ratio within a period of four (4) weeks from today. In default, the suspension order shall stand vacated.
