Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue of a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature writ of mandamus or any other writ as the Court may deem fit and proper declaring the inaction of the Respondent No.3 and 4 official authorities in considering the last and final representation dated 23.03.2026 to conduct survey and demarcate Naksha Road/Passage which is being used by the Pattadars to reach their agricultural properties through the said Naksha/Passage situated at the Village boundaries of both the Villages viz.. Chebarthy and Pamulaparthi, of Siddipet District, which passes through Chebarthy Village in Survey Nos. 417, 418, 419, and 420, and Pamulaparthi Village in Survey Nos.263 and 271, on the ground of alleged non-availability of the Village Map and Tippan without following any other alternate steps being illegal, unlawful, violation of principles of natural justice and equities and violation of constitutional rights guaranteed under article 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct all the official respondents to conduct survey as requested in the representation dated 23.03.2026 with the available revenue records and the copy of the Village Map enclosed to this writ petition and by examining the concerned Villagers of both the Villages of Chebarthy and Pamulaparthi, neighbouring agriculturists whose lands are located either side of the Naksha Road/Passage in the matter of access to agricultural properties of Villagers.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct Respondents to conduct survey and demarcate Naksha Road/Passage which is being used by the petitioners and other Pattadars to reach to their agricultural properties through the said Naksha/Passage situated at the Village boundaries of both the Villages viz., Chebarthy and Pamulaparthy, of Siddipet District, which passes through Chebarthy Village in Survey Nos. 417, 413, 419, and 420; and Pamulaparthy Village in Survey Nos. 263 and 271, with the available records and the documents filed along with the writ petition including the copy of the Village Map and without reference to the alleged non-availability of the Village Map and Tippan and by initiating any other alternate steps by examining and recording the statement of the Villagers by putting on all the concerned on notice before such survey, pending disposal of WP No 12067 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the AFFIDAVIT filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Ms. V. Kalyani, counsel representing, M/S Pearl Law Associates Advocate for the Petitioners, GP For Revenue for the Respondents, the Court made the following;

There shall be interim direction to respondent No.4 to complete survey pursuant to endorsement issued by respondent No.4 vide Lr.No.B/1087/2021 dated 16.12.2025 in respect of the subject land, by affording opportunity of hearing to all the parties, within period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
