WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI V YADU KRISHNA SAINATH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Civil Judge at Karimnagar, without proper transfer of Award to the Hon.ble Civil Court and the consequential action of the respondent no.5 in withholding the salary of the petitioner pursuant to warrant/order of Attachment Dt. 09.12.2025 in E.P No. 74 of 2024 in ARB. No 1200 of 2021 on the file of Hon'ble IV Addl. Junior Civil Judge at Karimnagar as illegal, improper, unjust, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and contrary to law and contrary to law and consequently quash the proceedings in E.P. No. 74 of 2024 in ARB. No.1200 of 2021 on the file of Hon'ble IV Addl. Junior Civil Judge at Karimnagar and further direct the respondents not to deduct the salary of the petitioner in the interest of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and Affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. V YADU KRISHNA SAINATH

Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR STAMPS AND REGISTRATION for respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and GP FOR IRRIGATION for respondent No.5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 16.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant direct the Respondent No.5 not to deduct the salary of the petitioner pursuant to the Salary Attachment warrant/order of Attachment Dt. 09.12.2025 in E.P. No. 74 of 2024 in ARB. No.1200 of 2021 on the file of Hon'ble III Addl. Junior Civil Judge at Karimnagar, pending disposal of WP No 12889 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:
ORDER

Notice before Admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and learned Government Pleader for Irrigation takes notice on behalf of respondent No.5, waives further notice and seeks time to file their respective counter-affidavits.

Registry is directed not to take out further notice to respondent Nos.1 to 3 and 5, in view of the above waiver.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Division Bench of this Court, in *Punyamuthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao v. Margadarsi Chit Fund Private Limited, Hyderabad and others* [reported in 2017 (3) ALD 387], held that the E.P. Court does not have jurisdiction to entertain an application

for execution of the award of the Deputy Registrar of Chit Funds, if presented by the decree- holder. However, in the instant case, respondent No.4 straight away filed E.P. before learned IV Additional Junior Civil Judge at Karimnagar. Therefore, learned counsel seeks indulgence of this Court.

In view of the above submission and the decision referred above, there shall be an interim stay as prayed for, insofar as the petitioner is concerned.

Post this matter on 16.07.2026 for counter-affidavit.
