WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri CHAITHANYA K presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ, order or direction especially one in the Nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.3 in interfering with civil disputes pending between the petitioners and the 4th respondent by calling the petitioners to the 3rd respondent police station without following due process of law and without any valid reasons, thereby interfering

with the personal liberty and day to day business activities of the petitioners on the instructions of the 4th respondent without following due process of law as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, unconstitutional, violative of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and against the principles of natural justice and consequently direct Se respondents 2 and 3 especially the respondent No.3 not to interfere with the civil disputes pending between the petitioners and 4th respondent by Calling the petitioners to the 3rd respondent police station without following due procedure of law.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri CHAITHANYA K Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Home Respondent Nos 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondents No 4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
