Heard Mr. B. Manav Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr. Jithendar Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1 and Mr. M. Vijaya Kanth, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2/<i>de-facto</i> complainant.
