RAGHAVENDAR RAO presented this Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be to quash the proceedings against the Petitioners herein/Accused No. 1 to 4 in C.C.No.6738 of 2022 on the file of the XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Manoranjan Complex at Hyderabad, arising from Crime No.81 of 2022, registered at P.S. WPS North Zone;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. B. Karthik, learned counsel representing Mr. D. Raghavendar Rao Advocate for the Petitioners and the Additional Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to Respondent No.2, herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 04.05.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO:1 OF 2026:

Petition Under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in C.C.No.6738 of 2022 on the file of the XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Manoranjan Complex at Hyderabad, arising from Crime No.81 of 2022, registered at P.S. WPS North Zone, pending disposal of CFLP No.5894 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following;
ORDER:**

Mr. B. Karthik, learned counsel representing Mr. D. Raghavendar Rao, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that accused No.1 and respondent No.2 have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding dated 06.12.2025. Pursuant to the said MOU, both parties agreed to withdraw the cases pending against each other and have obtained a decree of divorce by mutual consent *vide* order dated 14.02.2026 passed in F.C.O.P.No.376 of 2022 on the file of the Family Court, Secunderabad. Further, D.V.C.No. 236 of 2022 filed by respondent No.2 was also disposed of on 17.03.2026. It is further submitted that, in terms of the said MOU, accused No.1 has already paid two installments and he is ready and willing to pay the remaining installments. However, respondent No.2 has not come forward to cooperate for closure of the present C.C.No.6738 of 2022 pending on the file of the XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Manoranjan Complex, Hyderabad. Hence, continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners is required detailed examination.

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and seeks time.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.
