WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI B ARJUN presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent authorities more particularly respondent no.4 and 5 on influence of 6th and 7th respondent in trying to interfere and dispossess the petitioner from his rightful possession of his land to an extent of Ac. 2-0800 gts in Sy.No.113/4/1/1 situated at Andugulapet Village, Mandamarri Mandal, Mancherial District without following due process of law and principals of natural justice, pending consideration of Bhu-Bharathi application dated 01-10-2025 to restore his name in revenue records, which was deleted without

notice, as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, and contrary to the Provisions of Telangana Bhu-Bharati (Record of Rights) Act, 2025 and consequently direct the respondents to consider the Bhu-Bharati application dated 01-10-2025 to restore the petitioner's name in Bhu-Bharathi portal within time frame in respect of the subject land to an extent of Ac. 2-0800 gts in Sy.No.113/4/1/1 situated at Andugualapet Village, Mandamarri Mandal, Mancherial District.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. B ARJUN Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR REVENUE, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and GP FOR HOME, for the respondent No.5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 6 & 7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.6 and 7 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Petitioner claims to be the pattadar and possession of the subject land on the strength of pattadar pass book bearing No.T15140010361.

There shall be interim direction to respondent Nos.4 and 5 not to interfere with the possession of the petitioner in respect of the land

admeasuring Acs.2-0800 guntas in Survey No.113/4/1/1 situated at Andugualapet Village, Mandamarri Mandal, Mancheria District, without following due process of law.
