ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in Crime No.21 of 2026 of Maddirala Police Station, Suryapet District, registered for the offence punishable under Section 303 (2) of the BNS.

2. Heard Sri Alluri Divakar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri M. Ramachandra Reddy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent- State.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case without there being any material; that the petitioner is not arrayed as an accused in the present crime. However, the police authorities are trying to arrest the petitioner by falsely implicating him in the present case without there being any connecting material and hence, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner is not arrayed as an accused in the present case; that it is only the apprehension of the petitioner that the respondent may arrest him; that as of now, no case is registered against the petitioner and hence, he prays to dismiss the petition.

5. Recording submission made by learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.
