WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI. K MALLIKARJUN presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ or order or directions especially one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of Respondents that trying to dispossess the petitioner from her small shop in survey Number 11/1, situated at the edge of Naracheerala Pradesam, seethammavari vagu, Parnasala Village, Dummagudem Mandal, Bhadradi Kothagudem District by respondent No 6 and 7 and the respondents 2 to 5 are supporting the illegal acts of them and not taking any actions against to them is illegal, arbitrary and violate the Article 14 and 300A of constitution of India and besides being opposed to the principles of natural justice and direct the respondents not to interfere in the above said my shop;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and Affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. K MALLIKARJUN Advocate for the Petitioner, Ms. R. SNEHITHA REDDY, AGP FOR ASSIGNMENT for respondent

Nos. 1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 6 & 7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 02.05.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere into petitioner's shop in survey Number 11/1, situated at the edge of Naracheerala Pradesam, seethammavari vagu, Parnasala Village, Dummagudem Mandal, Bhadradi Kothagudem District. pending disposal of WP No 11942 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Issue notice to respondents No.6 and 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondents No.6 and 7 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Ms. R.Snehitha Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Assignment, appearing for respondents No.1 to 3, basing on the written instructions, submitted that respondent No.6 applied for NALA conversion in respect of the land admeasuring Ac.0-16 guntas in Survey No.11/1; it is his patta land. The application in proceedings No.2500071266 dated 13.02.2025 was allowed. The land in Survey No.11/1 is not a Government land and it is purely patta land belonging to respondent No.6. It is further submitted that there is civil dispute pending between the petitioner and respondents No.6 and 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as per the proceedings in Case No.3274 dated 04.12.1973, the said land was to be registered as waste land/poramboku and the structures raised by the petitioner are in the Government land.

However, as it is submitted by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Assignment that NALA order was passed in favour of respondent No.6, this Court is not inclined to pass any orders as of now.
