WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate M/S BHARADWAJ ASSOCIATES presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ and direct the respondents, more particularly Respondent Nos.2 and 3, not to interfere/coerce the petitioner as regards the possession of the plot admeasuring 520 square yards in Sy.Nos.314 and 315 of Akber Hills, in their anxiety to favour the respondents 4 to 6 and also direct the respondents 4 to 6 to avail civil law remedy in respect of the land claimed by them purportedly falling in Sy.No.337/5 of Akber Hills.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and AFFIDAVIT filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. Vedula Venkatarmana senior counsel appearing M/S BHARADWAJ ASSOCIATES

Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.4 to 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
