ORDER: *(per Hon'ble Sri Justice P.Sam Koshy)*

Heard Mr. C. Yadagiri, learned counsel for the petitioner,
and learned Government Pleader for Law, Legislative Affairs
appearing for respondents. Perused the record.

2. The instant writ petition has been filed assailing the
proceedings initiated by the Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial

Magistrate of First Class, Amangal, Ranga Reddy District, in O.S.No.55 of 2017.

3. At the first instance, we are not inclined to entertain this writ petition on the simple ground that this is not a case where the writ of prohibition can be exercised to decide the jurisdiction of the Civil Court seized of the matter. We are also not inclined to entertain this writ petition for the reason that the petitioner admits of having filed an I.A. questioning the jurisdiction of concerned Court and the I.A. is still being pending before the concerned Court. Lastly, we are also not inclined to entertain this writ petition for the reason that, if at all, if the petitioner has any grievance, nothing prevented him from approaching the concerned Bench by filing the proper civil revision petition in respect of the grievance that he has raised in the present writ petition.

4. It is also reflected that the very suit itself i.e., O.S.No.55 of 2017 stands decided and a preliminary decree is also passed as early as on 26.11.2018, the petitioner would have to take proper legal recourse available questioning the same before the appropriate legal forum as is permitted under law.



5. For the aforesaid reasons, the writ petition at this juncture is not maintainable and the same stands rejected. There shall be no order as to costs.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.

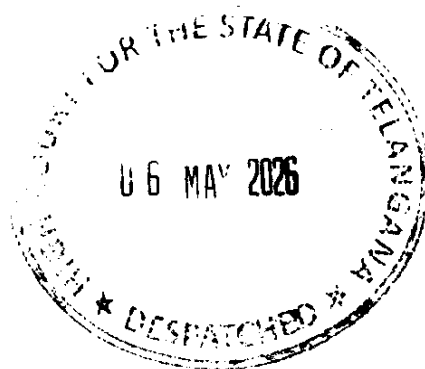
