ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue and Mr. Putta Krishna Reddy, learned standing counsel for respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the husband of the respondent No.5, namely, Kuthala Narsaiah, died in Bharatratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedka Municipal General Hospital in Mumbai on 14.12.1990. Accordingly, the death certificate was issued by the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai recording the date of death as 14.12.1990 vide date of registration dated 21.09.2024.



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3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioners, the respondent No.5 obtained fraudulent death certificate subsequently from the Korutla Municipality, Jagtial District, on 23.12.2024 recording the date of death as 14.03.1990. The said death certificate was obtained in order to make a false claim over the property sold by late Kuthala Narsaiah during his lifetime and in that connection, the petitioners submitted several representations, the latest being 09.04.2026, seeking cancellation of the death certificate issued on 23.12.2024.

4. In the circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to consider the representation of the petitioners dated 09.04.2026 for cancellation of alleged fraudulent death certificate bearing Id: 50103-D-18080 issued on 23.12.2024, by putting on notice the petitioners and the respondent No.5 and affording opportunity of hearing, within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. As this order is passed without entering into the merits of the case, notice to respondent No.5 is dispensed with.

The miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as costs.
