WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri M RATHAN SINGH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a command or order, More Particularly, one in the Nature of Writ of Mandamus, fortiori direct Respondent No.3 not to interfere with Civil issues, in between Petitioner and respondent No.4 and 5 to the writ Petition.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M RATHAN SINGH Advocate for the Petitioner and Asst. Government Pleader for Home for Respondent Nos.1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.4 & 5 to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 30.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct Respondent No.3 to the writ Petition, not to Meddle Civil Petitioner Civil issues, in between Petitioner and respondents No.4 and 5 to the writ Petition, Pending disposal of WP No 12395 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Mr. M.Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and also seeks time to obtain instructions/file counter, if necessary.

Issue notice, including personal notice to respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Mr. M.Ratan Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that there are civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent Nos.4 and 5 where the petitioner obtained *ad-interim* injunction dated 06.04.2026 in I.A.No.120 of 2026 in O.S.No.247 of 2026 on the file of the II Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-IX Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Medchal. Learned counsel further submits that at the behest of respondent Nos.4 and 5, without following the due process of law, respondent No.3 is interfering with the civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent Nos.4 and 5.

This matter requires detailed examination and the facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions/counter by the official respondents.

List on 30.06.2026.

In the meantime, respondent No.3 is directed not to interfere with the *inter se* civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent Nos.4 and 5 without following due process of law.
