AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI MANDRU SAMBASIVA RAO Advocate for the

Petitioner and SRI M. SRINIVAS, AGP FOR HOME appears for the Respondents no. 1 to 5 directed issue of notice to the Respondent no.6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that respondent Nos.4 and 5 have not taken any action on the complaint dated 31.12.2025 stated to have been submitted by the petitioner against respondent No.6 and prays this Court to direct respondent Nos.4 and 5 to register crime in pursuance of the complaint of the petitioner.

This matter requires detailed examination and the facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions/counter by the official respondents.

In the meantime, respondent No.5 is directed to file a status report with regard to the complaint dated 31.12.2025 stated to have been filed by the petitioner and the action taken.
