WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI Y SURESH KUMAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, to declare the illegal and arbitrary lien placed by Respondent No.2 State Bank of India on the Petitioner's Savings Account No. 62169896592 pursuant to the interim order dated 20.02.2026 passed in ACP.NO.TA/SM/MCCI /407 OF 2026), without any authority or jurisdiction and consequently set aside the same, directing Respondent No. 1 to forthwith release the lien on the Petitioner's Savings Account No. 62169896592 and restore full access to the Petitioner to operate his account.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI. Y SURESH KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri N. Bhujanga Rao, Deputy Solicitor General of India for the respondent No.1-Union of India, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 to 4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
