SAI PRASEN GUNDAVARAM presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.100 of 2025 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class - Spl.(Mobile)-PCR Act, Ranga Reddy - cum - IV Addl. Metropolitan Magistrate - cum - IV Addl. Junior Civil Judge, Ranga Reddy District at L.B. Nagar, filed by Respondent No.2 under Section 12 of the Protection of Women From Domestic Violence Act 2005;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SAI PRASEN GUNDAVARAM, Advocate for the Petitioners, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2, herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before **03.08.2026** to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the

memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be to STAY all further proceedings in D.V.C.No.100 of 2025 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class-Spl.(Mobile) PCR Act, Ranga Reddy-cum-IV Addl. Metropolitan Magistrate-cum-IV Addl. Junior Civil Judge, Ranga Reddy District at L.B. Nagar, pending disposal of CRLP No.5931 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that respondent No.2 filed D.V.C.No.100 of 2025 against the petitioners and her husband, claiming various reliefs, though there is no domestic relationship between the petitioners and respondent No.2. Hence, the ingredients of the provisions of Sections 18(e) and 22 of the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 are not attracted against the petitioners and the continuation of the proceedings against them is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners, require detailed examination.

Notice before admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Post on 03.08.2026.

The presence of the petitioners in D.V.C.No.100 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class-Special (Mobile) PCR Act, Ranga Reddy District at L.B.Nagar, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners is

required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of their non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
