AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Hemendranath Reddy R.N., Senior Counsel representing Sri. M SHIVA KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings against the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 3 in C.C.No.2618 of 2025 on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge-Cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Ranga Reddy District at L.B.Nagar.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Sri Hemendranath Reddy R.N., learned Senior Counsel representing Sri M. Shiva Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that the petitioners have not committed the alleged offences and have been falsely implicated in the present case. The allegations levelled in the complaint are purely civil in nature. Even according to the allegations made either in the complaint or in the final report, the ingredients of the offences under Sections 120-B, 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 38 of The Telangana Mutually Aided Cooperative Societies Act, 1995 are not attracted against the petitioners. He further submits that the petitioners have approached this Court and filed Crl.P.No .6851 of 2021 seeking for quashing of the proceedings against them in

Crime No.670 of 2021 of Ramachandrapuram Police Station, Cyberabad Commissionerate, Sangareddy District, and this Court, while ordering notice before admission, granted interim stay on all further proceedings, while recording reasons on 09.09.2021. Respondent No.2/*de facto* complainant himself submitted a letter to the Inspector of Police, EOW Police Station, Gachibowli, requesting for withdrawal of the complaint. However, the Investigating Officer, without considering the said request, proceeded to file the final report, and the learned Trial Court has taken cognizance of the same. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds raised by the learned Senior counsel for the petitioners require detailed examination.

Post on 06.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 and 3 in C.C.No.2618 of 2025 on the file of the Principal Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Ranga Reddy District at L.B. Nagar.

In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
