WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI MATHANGI PRADEEP presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order, or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of respondents particularly respondent 03 and 4 in conducting biased inquiry and issuing final inquiry report without addressing the grave issue in the petitioner representation dated 26.06.2024, which is illegal, unconstitutional in violation of article 14, 21 and 300A of the constitution of India against the principles of natural justice and consequently direct the respondent authorities, particularly respondent 02 to take appropriate action for biased inquiry and consequently set-aside the inquiry report of the respondent 03 i.e. Lr.No.C/5728/2024 dated 06.11.2024;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. MATHANGI PRADEEP Advocate for the Petitioner and Asst. GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.6 to 8 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
