ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.2 in Crime No.167 of 2026 of Mokila Police Station, Future City District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 316 (2), 318 (4), 308 (2), 351(2) 61 read with 3 (5) of the BNS.

2. Heard Dasi Ramesh, learned counsel for the petitioner-Accused No.2 and Sri M. Ramachandra Reddy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent- State.

3. Without going into the merits of the case, since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioner is less than seven (07) years, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer on or before 05.05.2026 between 11:00 a.m. and 05:00 p.m. and in turn, the Investigating Officer is directed to follow the procedure laid down under Section 35 (3) of BNSS (previously Section 41-A of Cr.P.C.) and also the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar***¹ scrupulously. However, the petitioner shall submit his defence and co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when required by furnishing information and produce all relevant documents/material required for the purpose of the investigation. On furnishing the same, the Investigating Officer shall consider the same

before filing appropriate report before the learned Magistrate concerned.

4. With the above direction, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.
