WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri P.Devender, presented this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus, declaring action of the respondents 2 & 3 in not taking any action on the complaints of the petitioner dated 26.03.2026 and 06.04.2026 respectively seeking for necessary action on the illegal construction being made by respondents 4 and 5 in house premises bearing No. 3-3-72 and 3-3-72/1, situated at Kummarigadda, Medak Town, Medak District as highly illegal, arbitrary and in violation to the construction rules envisaged under the Telangana Municipalities Act, consequently direct the respondents 2 and 3 to forthwith take immediate necessary action on the complaints of the petitioner dated 26.03.2026 and 06.04.2026 respectively, by stopping the illegal construction being made by respondents 4 and 5 in house premises bearing No. 3-3-72 and 3-3-72/1, situated at Kummarigadda, Medak Town, Medak District;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed therein, and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P.Devender, Advocate for the Petitioner,

directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 4 & 5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 15-06-2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C., praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 2 & 3 to forthwith take immediate necessary action on the complaints of the petitioner dated 26.03.2026 and 06.04.2026 respectively, by stopping the illegal construction being made by respondents 4 & 5 in house premises bearing No. 3-3-72 & 3-3-72/1, situated at Kummarigadda, Medak Town, Medak District, pending disposal of WP No. 11983 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Issue notice to respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.4 and 5 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are beneficiaries of Indiramma Housing Scheme, are trying to construct houses by encroaching into cement concrete road and drainage manhole on the Northern and Eastern side of the petitioner's property. Learned counsel submitted that if construction is allowed and there is encroachment of common passage by respondent Nos.4 and 5, then it would be difficult for the petitioner to repair the drainage at later point of time.

Learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.2 submitted that on receipt of complaint from the petitioner, construction being undertaken by respondent Nos.4 and 5 was stopped.

There shall be interim direction to respondent No.2 to forthwith stop construction activity made by respondent Nos.4 and 5 over the subject property, until further orders.
