ORDER

Issue notice to respondent Nos.5, 6 and 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.5, 6 and 7 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Petitioners claim to be the pattadars and possessors of the subject lands on the strength of Ex.P2 - pattadar pass books. The grievance of the

petitioners is that there is interference by respondent No.4 in their possession over the subject lands without following due process of law.

There shall be interim direction to respondent No.4 - Tahsildar, Chennur Mandal, Mancherial District, not to interfere with the possession of the petitioners over the subject lands i.e., Acs.2-00 guntas in Survey No.77/7 (Old No.77), Ac.1-00 guntas in Survey No.77/8 (Old No.77), Ac.2-00 guntas in Survey No.77/9 (Old No.77), Ac.1-00 guntas in Survey No.77/10 (Old No.77) and Ac.2-00 guntas in Survey No.76/6 (Old No.76) situated at Shivalingapur Village, Chennur Mandal, Mancherial District, without following due process of law.
