WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI. POCHIAH DORISHETTI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a appropriate writ, order or orders, more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus and direct the respondent No. 2 under the influence of Respondents Nos.4 not to call the petitioners to the Police Station frequently, not to threaten the petitioner and his family members being it is civil dispute without there being any FIR,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. POCHIAH DORISHETTI Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 29.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to issue a direction to the Respondents to follow the due process of law without there being any FIR registered against the petitioner and not to call the petitioner to the police station, Pending disposal of WP No 12109 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and waives further notice. He seeks time to obtain instructions and make submissions.

Issue notice to respondent No.4.

Personal notice is permitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that without there being any registration of crime against the petitioner, respondent No.2 is interfering with the *inter se* private civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent No.4 which is illegal and arbitrary. Therefore, he seeks to pass appropriate orders.

This matter requires detailed examination.

The facts can be ascertained only upon filing counter by respondents.

Meanwhile, respondent No.2 is directed not to interfere with the *inter se* private disputes between the petitioner and respondent No.4 except by following the procedure contemplated under law.
