WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI BVSS BALAKRISHNA RANJIT presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondent Nos. 3 to 8 in not conducting the investigation in Crime No. 181 of 2025, dated. 22.07.2025 registered on the file of the 8th respondent police station and not registered the complaint within stipulated period even after receiving the complaint dated. 21.07.2014 from the Superintendent of Police and complaint dated. 21.04.2025 from the Hon'ble Minister and not issuing the missing certificate of my mother by name Chapla Laxmi @ Solam Laxani and inaction of the respondent Nos 9 to 11 in not process the pension papers of my father by name Solam Venkanna @ sVenkataiah and service/pension benefits of my mother is illegal, arbitrary, contrary to the principles of natural Justice, violation of Art.14,19 and 21 of Constitution of India and bad in law and consequently direct the respondent Nos. 3 to 8 to issue the Missing Certificate of the mother of the petitioner by name Chapla Laxmi @ Solam Laxmi by completing investigation or to trace out the whereabouts of the mother of the petitioner by name Chapla Laxmi @ Solam Laxmi and also direct the respondent Nos. 9 to 11 to process the pension papers of the father and mother of the petitioner by name Solam Venkanna @ Venkataiah and Chapla Laxmi @ Solam Laxmi along with all service benefits and all consequential benefits.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. BVSS BALAKRISHNA RANJIT Advocate for the Petitioner, Mr. M.Srinivas, Assistant Government Pleader for Home, for respondent Nos.1, 3, 5, 6, 7 & 8, Assistant Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj, for respondent No.2, Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, for respondent No.4 and Sri K. Pradeep Reddy, standing Counsel represented by Sri Santosh Reddy, for respondent Nos.9 and 10, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.11, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
