Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ or direction preferably Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent No.2, in not receiving, registering and releasing the Release Deed presented in respect of Residential House No. 30-59/7/2, on Plot No. 54, in Sy. No. 342/1 and 341, admeasuring about 215 Sq. Yrds. or 179.74 Sq. Mtrs. consisting of

Two Rooms, Latrin, Bathroom and some open space, and situated at Old Safilguda, Malkajgiri, Medchal-Malkajgiri (erstwhile Rangareddy District), is illegal, arbitrary and contrary to provisions of law and violation of Article 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondent No.2 to receive, process, register and release the Release Deed/ any other deeds that may be presented by the Petitioners in respect of Residential House No. 30-59/7/2, on Plot No. 54, in Sy. No. 342/1 & 341, admeasuring about 215 Sq. Yrds. or 179.74 Sq. Mtrs. consisting of Two Rooms, Latrin, Bathroom and some open space, and situated at Old Safilguda, Malkajgiri, Medchal-Malkajgiri (erstwhile Rangareddy District), without insisting No-objection Certificate (NOC) from the Respondent No.3.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.2 forthwith to receive, process, register and release the subject Release Deed/any other deeds presented by the Petitioner in respect of Residential House No. 30-59/7/2, on Plot No. 54, in Sy. No. 342/1 & 341, admeasuring about 215 Sq. Yrds. or 179.74 Sq. Mtrs. consisting of Two Rooms, Latrin, Bathroom and some open space, and situated at Old Safilguda, Malkajgiri, Medchal-Malkajgiri (erstwhile Rangareddy District), without insisting No-objection Certificate (NOC) from the Respondent No.3, pending disposal of the writ petition in the interest of justice.

ORDER :

With the consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal at the stage of admission.

2. Heard Ms. B. Jyothirmmai, learned counsel for the petitioners; Ms. S. Sravanthi, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration, appearing for respondent Nos.1 and 2; and Mr. Farhan Azam Khan, learned Standing Counsel for Telangana Waqf Board, appearing for respondent No.3.

3. Aggrieved by the action of respondent No.2 in refusing to receive, register and release the Release Deed presented by the petitioners in respect of subject property i.e., Residential House No.30-59/7/2, on Plot No.54, in Sy.Nos.342/1 and 341, admeasuring about 215 Sq. Yrds. or 179.74 Sq. Mtrs. situated at Old Safilguda, Malkajgiri, Medchal-Malkajgiri (erstwhile Rangareddy District), the petitioners filed the present Writ Petition.

4. Learned Government Pleader submits that the official respondents will follow the procedure contemplated under Section 71 of the Registration Act, 1908.

5. Section 71 of the Registration Act, 1908 reads as follows:

Reasons for refusal to register to be recorded.—

- (1) Every Sub-Registrar refusing to register a document, except on the ground that the property to which it relates is not situated within his sub-district shall make an order of refusal and recorded his reasons for such order in his Book No.2, and endorse the words "registration refused" on the document; and, on application made by any person executing or claiming under the document, shall, without payment and unnecessary delay, give him a copy of the reasons so recorded.

- (2) No registering officer shall accept for registration a document so endorsed unless and until, under the provisions hereinafter contained, the document is directed to be registered.

6. In view of the above submissions coupled with the provision under Section 71 of the Registration Act, 1908, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the Registering Authority to receive and process the document sought to be presented by the petitioners in respect of the subject property, subject to the petitioners complying with the provisions of the Registration Act, 1908 as well as the Indian Stamp Act, 1899. It will be open to the Registering Authority to refuse registration of the document presented before him, if he has any objection, and he shall assign reasons in support of such decision and shall also communicate the same to the petitioners. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case as to the entitlement of the petitioners to get the subject document registered.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

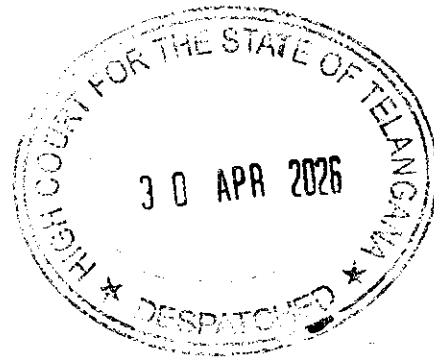
