WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri N Manohar presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 3rd respondent RDO in not issuing Occupancy Rights Certificate, pursuant to the order dt.24.02.2024 in case No.H/1733/2020 as illegal, arbitrary and in violation of principles natural justice and contrary to the provisions of A.P (T.A) Abolition of Inams Act, 1955 and rules made thereunder, consequently to direct the 3rd respondent to issue the same.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri N Manohar Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 23.06.2025 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

The Court made the following ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Sri L.Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, takes notice for respondent Nos.1 to 4 and seeks time to file counter-affidavit.

It is stated by the learned Assistant Government Pleader that the petitioner was granted Occupancy Rights Certificate (ORC) under the provisions of the Telangana Abolition of Inams Act, 1955 and the Rules made thereunder. Questioning the said ORC an appeal was filed before the Additional District Collector, Medak and the said appeal was dismissed. Aggrieved by the said order passed by the appellate authority a writ petition i.e., W.P.No.7291 of 2024 came to be filed before this Court and this Court has granted *status quo* in the said writ petition and the same is pending for consideration.

In view of the same, post this writ petition on 23.06.2025 along with W.P.No.7291 of 2024.
