Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction especially one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring that, a) the action of the Respondents in not making payment of terminal benefits to the Petitioner in pursuance of letter/ proceedings issued by the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Hyderabad in Lr. No. PAG(A&E)/P16/I/R-339/SP383/2025-06/1974 Dt.06.08.2025 is illegal, arbitrary and discriminatory, violating Article 14, 16 and 300-A of the Constitution of India. b) further declare that, the Respondents shall forthwith release all terminal benefits payable to the Petitioner including Death-cum-Retirement, Gratuity, Commutation of Pension, General Provident Fund amount and encashment of Earned Leave and Earned Leave

amount and other benefits in pursuance of his retirement dated 31.08.2025 and the proceedings in Lr.No.PAG(A&E)/P16/1/R-339/SP383/2025-06/1974 Dt.06.08.2025 of the Principal Accountant General (AandE), Hyderabad viz., an amount of Rs.16,00,000/- sanctioned towards retirement gratuity viz., Rs.10,04,099/- sanctioned vide Token No.2601311717 dated 12.09.2025 and Rs.5,95,901/- sanctioned vide Token No.2601311724 dated 12.09.2025 respectively, further an amount of Rs.17,87,906/- sanctioned towards Commutation Value of Pension viz., Rs.11,22,021/- sanctioned vide Token No.2601311734 dated 12.09.2025 and Rs.6,65,885/- sanctioned vide Token No.2601311742 dated 12.09.2025 respectively, the Service Pension of the Petitioner was fixed as Rs.46,025/-, GPF amount of Rs.11,78,236/- sanctioned vide Cheque/Token No.2602794580 dated 19.01.2026, Encashment of Leave amount of Rs.8,80,928/- sanctioned vide Token No.2601322283 dated 12.09.2025, GIS amount of Rs.41,304/- sanctioned vide Token No.2601322540 dated 12.09.2025 and PRC Arrears (12 Bills) amount of Rs.2,39,806/- sanctioned vide different token numbers on 13.10.2025. c) the Respondents have no right or power to withhold the terminal benefits payable to the Petitioner after his retirement.
