ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioners/respondent Nos. 2 and 3 seeking to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.431 of 2025 on the file of IV Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Kalpatharu, Hyderabad, for the offences under Section 85 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short, 'BNS') and Section 3 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 (for short, 'DP Act').

2. Heard Ms. S.Manjula, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.Jithender Rao Vecramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.

3. When this Court is not inclined to entertain the criminal petition on the ground that specific allegations are levelled against the petitioners and that the grounds raised in the criminal petition require adjudication by the trial

Court, at this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioners requested this Court to dispense with the presence of the petitioners/respondent Nos.2 and 3 in D.V.C.No.431 of 2025 on the file of IV Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Kalpatharu, Hyderabad.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for petitioners.

5. In view of the above submissions, the presence of the petitioners/respondent Nos.2 and 3 in D.V.C.No.431 of 2025 on the file of IV Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Kalpatharu, Hyderabad, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of his non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for his appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
