MALLESHA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or Direction, more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the Respondent-3 in not disposing the appeal filed by the Petitioners for the property covering an extent of Ac. 2.22 gts covered by Survey numbers. 65/A/3 (65/13), Extent Ac. 0.21 guntas, 66/AA /3, (Sy.No. 66/13) Extent Ac.0.32 Guntas, Sy No. 68/U1/1 (68/1/1) Extent Ac.0.39 Guntas and Sy No.65/EE/3 (Sy.No.65/22/3) Extent Ac.0.10 gts situated at Thangadapalli Revenue Village of Choutuppal Mandal, Yadadri-Bhongir District, as wholly , unjust , arbitrary and violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently restrain the Respondents from dealing with the property in any manner as it belongs to the petitioners.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. B·MALLESHA Advocate for the Petitioner, and Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue for respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
