WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Shri ASHUTOSH B JOSHI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or orders one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction on part of the respondent No.2 in protecting the properties attached vide R.C.No.776 of 2021 dated 19.08.2022 published in Gazette No.31/MNCL/2022 dated 19.08.2022, despite several representation made by the petitioners, more fully the latest representation dated 30.10.2025 as illegal, arbitrary, and contrary to the provisions of Revenue Recovery Act, 1864 besides being act tantamounting to monetary loss to the petitioners and violative of fundamentals rights of the petitioners under article 19 and 21 and 300-A of the Constitution, consequently direct the respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 30.10.2025 of the petitioner and in context thereto for safeguard and protect subject property, subject matter of R.C.No.776 of 2021 dated

19.08.2022 published in Gazette No.31/MNCL/2022 dated 19.08.2022 on its file till the matter is sub judice in the W.P.No.34580 of 2022 is disposed.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Shri. ASHUTOSH B JOSHI Advocate for the Petitioner and Mr. A Chandra Shaker Standing Counsel for TGNPDCL for respondent No.3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

ORDER:

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue produced written instructions and submitted that the Management of the petitioner Company has not paid pending dues to the Government and showing negligence in protecting their properties; several letters have been addressed to the Management by the District Collector to keep proper security; and that if the Management is ready to pay the expenditure incurred, respondent No.2 will arrange security.

Issue notice to respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Print the name of Mr. A Chandra Shaker, learned Standing Counsel for TGNPDCL, for respondent No.3.
