WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI SYED WAHEED ALI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondent police officials, particularly Respondent No.5, in illegally interfering with the petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of his property situated in Sy.No.587, Kolthur Village, Muduchintalpally Mandal, Medchal Malkajgiri District, Telangana, at the instance of unofficial Respondent No.6, by summoning the petitioner to the police station, threatening him not to enter his own land, and coercing him to settle a purely private dispute, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondent police, particularly

Respondent Nos. 5, not to interfere in the civil property dispute between the petitioner and unofficial Respondent No.6 except in accordance with due process of law.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. SYED WAHEED ALI Advocate for the Petitioner and Mr. M Srinivas, ASST GP FOR HOME, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.6, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

You viz:

Sri. P.Ramreddy, S/o P.Sathireddy, occupation Business, R/o Alwal, Secunderabad, Hyderabad

are directed to show cause on or before 30.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents police, particularly Respondent Nos. 5, not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of his property and not to call the petitioner to the police station or take any coercive steps against him at the instance of unofficial Respondent No.6, except in accordance with due process of law, pending disposal of WP No 12456 of 2026 on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Mr. M.Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 and also seeks time to obtain instructions/file counter, if necessary.

Issue notice, including personal notice to respondent No.6.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that without following due process of law, at the instance of respondent No.6, respondent No.5 is interfering with the civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent No.6.

This matter requires detailed examination and the facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions/counter by the official respondents.

List on 30.06.2026.

In the meantime, respondent No.5 is directed not to interfere with the *inter se* civil disputes between the petitioner and unofficial respondent without following due process of law.
