WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri. ABHINAV KRISHNA UPPALURI presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings against the Petitioners/Accused in CC.No.951 of 2022 dated: 19.04.2022 registered under Sections 498A IPC and Section 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, pending on the file of VII AJCJ-cum- XXXII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, At Kukatpally, Cyberabad in the interest of justice and equity.

AND. WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. ABHINAV KRISHNA UPPALURI Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 22.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be to stay of all proceedings against the Petitioners/Accused in CC.No.951 of 2022 dated:19/04/2022 registered under Sections 498A IPC and Section 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, pending on the file of VII AJCJ-cum- XXXII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate. at Kukatpally, Cyberabad in the interest of justice and equity.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed the alleged offence and have been falsely implicated in the present case solely on the ground that they are the parents of accused No. 1. Respondent No. 2 never lived with the petitioners, and the petitioners never demanded any additional dowry as alleged in the complaint, nor harassed her. Hence, the ingredients of the offences under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 are not attracted against the petitioners. Respondent No. 2 has made omnibus allegations against the petitioners. Therefore, continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of the process of law. In support of his contention, learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the principle laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in *M.Nirupama and others v. State of Andhra Pradesh and others* [Crl.A.No.4245 of 2024] wherein, the Hon'ble Apex Court relied upon the

principle in *Kahkashan Kausar and others v. State of Bihar and others* [(2022) 6 Supreme Court Cases 599].

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

In view of the above, issue notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Post on 22.06.2026.

The presence of the petitioners/accused Nos.2 and 3 in C.C.No.951 of 2022 on the file of the VII Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-XXXII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Kukatpally, Cyberabad, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of their non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
