WHEREAS the PetitionerS above named through their Advocate Sri VINAY KRISHNA KODALI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed

therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus.

- i) declaring the action of the Respondents in insisting upon online counseling and centralized allotment of students to the Petitioner Institutions, including by issuance of Notification dated 13.04.2026 for the Academic Year 2026-27, as arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional, without authority of law and contrary to the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, and consequently set aside the same,
- ii) consequentially directing the Respondents not to enforce the online admission process in respect of undergraduate courses in the Petitioner Colleges and not to interfere with the Petitioners' own process of admissions into the various undergraduate courses for the Academic Year 2026-27.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. VINAY KRISHNA KODALI Advocate for the Petitioners, Asst. Government Pleader for Higher Education for Respondent Nos.1 & 2, Sri A.P. Suresh Ram, Standing Counsel for TGCHE for Respondent Nos.3 and 4 and Sri Malipeddi Srinivas Reddy, Standing Counsel for Osmania University for Respondent No.5 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Mr. K.Sharath, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Higher Education takes notice for respondent Nos.1 and 2 and seeks time to file counter-affidavit.

Mr. A.P.Suresh Ram, learned Standing Counsel for TGCHE takes notice for respondent Nos.3 and 4 and seeks time to file counter-affidavit.

Mr. Malipeddi Srinivas Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Osmania University takes notice for respondent No.5 and seeks time to file counter-affidavit.

List on 30.06.2026.

Sri Vinay Krishna Kodali, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that this Court, by orders, dated 18.05.2023 and 25.05.2023 in W.P.No.13392 of 2023 and batch and W.P.No.13499 of 2023 respectively, had directed the respondents therein not to interfere with the admission process of the petitioners-colleges into various undergraduate courses, by excluding the petitioners-institutions from the DOST Admission process. Hence, he prayed to grant the same relief to the petitioners herein.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Higher Education does not dispute the same.

In view of the above and for the reasons recorded in the orders, dated 18.05.2023 and 25.05.2023 in W.P.No.13392 of 2023 and batch and W.P.No.13499 of 2023 respectively, there shall be interim direction to the respondents herein not to interfere with the petitioners' process of admissions into various undergraduate courses of study for the academic year 2026-27, excluding the petitioner institutions from the DOST admission process.
