ORDER

Upon perusal of the record it reveals that the learned Magistrate, without recording satisfaction and without assigning any reasons, has taken cognizance against the petitioner for the offences punishable under Sections 448, 341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and issued summons, and the same is contrary to the principles laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Sunil Bharati Mittal v. Central Bureau of Investigation*¹ and *Fakhruddin Ahmad v. State of Uttaranchal and another*².

In view of the above, issue notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.
