ORDER:

This Criminal Petition has been filed by the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 seeking quashing of C.C.No.15605 of 2019 on the file of VII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad, for the offences under Section 324 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. Heard Eluri Kalyan Kumar, learned counsel, representing Mr. Mohd. Moin Ahmed Quadri, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.Jithendar Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of respondent No.1.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed an application before the learned trial Court in C.C.No.15605 of 2019 for seeking discharge for the offences levelled against the petitioners. The said application is pending and the

learned trial Court is adjourning the matter from time to time, without any valid reasons. Unless this Court issues necessary directions, the parties will be put to great hardship.

4. Though the present Criminal Petition has been filed seeking quashing of the proceedings, learned counsel for the petitioners requested this Court to issue necessary direction to the learned trial Court for expedite disposal of the application filed by the petitioners.

5. Taking into consideration the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court without expressing any view on the merits of the case, directs the learned of VII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad, to dispose of the application filed by the petitioners, seeking discharge for the offences levelled against them in C.C.No.15065 of 2019, as expeditiously as possible, within a period of two (02) months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. The parties in the *lis* are directed to cooperate with the trial Court without seeking any undue adjournment.

6. With the above said direction, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
