WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI PULLA RAO YELLANKI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of mandamus, to declare the action of the 4th Respondent in not conducting survey in respect of land to an extent of Ac.6-00gts, in sy. no. 115/0.1, situated at Kakarla Village, Julurpad mandal, Bhadradri Kothagudem District, despite notice being issued on 29.09.2025 to the petitioner as well as respondent no.6 to appear on 06.10.2025 before the respondent no.4 and the respondent no.4 went on postponing the survey of the land without valid reasons, even this Hon'ble court was pleased to pass orders in WP no. 39609 of 2022 and batch cases dated. 25.04.2023 categorically held that pursuant to the ROR act,2020, CCLA issued circular no. 1/2021 dated. 15.01.2021 to survey and sub-division the

scheduled land is as being illegal, arbitrary, and unconstitutional and for other reliefs and violation of articles 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 4th Respondent to conduct survey and demarcate the subject land with the help of Police.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. PULLA RAO YELLANKI Advocate for the Petitioner, Mr. L Ravinder, ASST GP FOR REVENUE, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and GP FOR HOME, for the respondent No.5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No. 6, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 01.05.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass orders forthwith directing the 4th Respondent to conduct survey and demarcate the subject land to an extent of Ac.6-00gts, in sy. no. 115/0.1, situated at Kakarla village, Julurpad Mandal, Bhadradri Kothagudem District, with the help of Police, pending disposal of WP No 12975 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

Issue notice to respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.6 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Mr. L.Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, appearing for respondents No.1 to 4, basing on the written instructions, submitted that the survey application dated 01.08.2025 submitted by the petitioner was not considered as there are two (2) decrees passed i.e. one in favour of the petitioner and the other in favour of respondent No.6 and the parties were directed to approach competent civil Court.

A copy of the written instructions along with the endorsement and reports of respondent No.4 is served on the learned counsel for the petitioner.
