A SANJEEVA REDDY presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to Quash the Charge Sheet no.13443/2020 filed before III Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad against Petitioner/Accused no.3 in the interest of justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. BANDARI PRASHANTH, Counsel representing Sri. A SANJEEVA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 04.05.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Mr. Bandari Prashanth, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that accused No.1 had approached this Court and filed Crl.P.No.4772 of 2017, seeking to quash the very same proceedings against him in Crime No.307 of 2017 and this Court on 13.10.2022, allowed the said criminal petition, quashing the proceedings against accused No.1. The Investigating Officer after conducting investigation, filed final report before III Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, at Hyderabad and the same was numbered as C.C.No.13443 of 2020. By virtue of quashing the proceedings against accused No.1, the petitioner is also entitled for the very same benefit on the ground that very same allegations are levelled against the petitioner. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, issue notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.
