WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI. N RAVI PRASAD presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to.

(a) Issue a Writ of Certiorari or a writ, order or direction in the nature thereof, calling for the records leading to the passing of (i) Letter No. Lr.No.307/AC4/KNRUHS/2025 dated 01-02-2025 (the First Impugned Order') and (ii) Letter No. Lr.No.2087/AC4/KNRUHS/2026 dated 24-03-2026 (the 'Second Impugned Order'), both passed by Respondent No. 2 in pursuance of orders of the Vice-Chancellor, and upon examination, quash and set aside both orders as being illegal, arbitrary, perverse, passed without notice, passed without hearing, passed on an incomplete and incorrect factual record, contrary to the Vice-Chancellor's own direction dated 25-09-2025, and violative of the Petitioner's fundamental rights guaranteed under Articles 19(1)(g) and 21 of the Constitution of India

(b) and consequently direct the Respondent No. 2 to forthwith grant re-admission to the Petitioner to the MD (Radio-Diagnosis) 2020-21 Batch course at

Respondent No. 3 (KIMS, Narketpally), treating the period of his absence from 25-08-2021 as condoned absence caused by circumstances beyond his control including the institutional fee dispute, COVID-induced financial hardship, and personal bereavement, and not as voluntary absence warranting forfeiture, and further treating the re-admission application dated 10-05-2023 as having been made within the prescribed two-year period.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. Manoj Makireddy, counsel representing Mr. N. Ravi Prasad, counsel for the petitioner, Mr. R. Nagarjuna Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Health, Medical and Family Welfare Department, for respondent No.1, and Mr. T. Sharath, learned Standing Counsel for the Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, for respondent No.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3. herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
