Ms. G.Shalini, learned Assistant Government Pleader attached to the office of the learned Advocate General for the State of Telangana appears for respondents No.1 and 2 in W.P.No.9033 of 2004 and respondent No.1 in W.P.No.23289 of 2004. Mr. P.Akhileswar, learned counsel representing Mr. A.Tulsi Raj Gokul, learned Standing Counsel for State Legislative Assembly appears for respondent No.4 in W.P.No.9033 of 2004 and respondent No.2 in W.P.No.23289 of 2004. Reference is made to the earlier order dated 03.07.2025: “Today when the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as on today except petitioner Nos.3 and 6, the other petitioners i.e., petitioner Nos.1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9 have already crossed the age of superannuation, the relief sought for in the writ petition cannot be granted in respect of petitioner Nos.1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9 are concerned as the cause in respect those petitioners may not survive for further adjudication. In addition, learned counsel further submits that so far as petitioner No.6 is concerned, in view of State Re-Organization, she has been transferred to the State of Andhra Pradesh and she has been working with the Andhra Pradesh State Legislative Assembly. Since petitioner No.6 is working with the A.P. State Legislative Assembly, the High Court of Telangana may not have jurisdiction to entertain the present writ petition so far as petitioner No.6 is concerned and at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the writ petition so far as petitioner No.6 is concerned with a liberty to file the same before the High Court of Andhra Pradesh. Lastly he submits that the present writ petition is now confined only in so far as petitioner No.3 i.e., P.Humayu Kabir is concerned and he prays for a short adjournment.
