WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate SRI. D A PREM CHAND presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of Respondent No. 4, in filing the EP No. 761 of 2025 in A.R.B No. 284 of 2018, on the file of the learned X Junior

Civil Judge, City Civil Courts, Hyderabad, is illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional, and contrary to the provisions of the Chit Fund Act, 1982, and Rules, consequently by setting aside the proceedings of EP No. 761 of 2025 in A.R.B No. 284 of 2018, and to declare that the 4th Respondent has no jurisdiction to execute the award and the recovery certificate, for attachment of moveable property of Petitioners herein;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and Affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. D A PREM CHAND Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR STAMPS & REGISTRATION for respondent Nos. 1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 16.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in E.P. No. 761 of 2025 in A.R.B No. 284 of 2018. on the file of learned X Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Courts, Hyderabad, pending disposal of WP No 12772 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:
ORDER

Notice before Admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice and seeks time to file counter-affidavit.

Registry is directed not to take out further notice to respondent Nos.1 to 3, in view of the above waiver.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the Division Bench of this Court, in *Punyamuthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao v. Margadarsi Chit Fund Private Limited, Hyderabad and others* [reported in 2017 (3) ALD 387], held that the E.P. Court does not have jurisdiction to entertain an application for execution of the award of the Deputy Registrar of Chit Funds, if presented by the decree-holder. However, in the instant case, respondent No.4 straight away filed E.P. before learned X Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad. Therefore, learned counsel seeks indulgence of this Court.

In view of the above submission and the decision referred above, there shall be an interim stay as prayed for, insofar as the petitioners are concerned.

Post this matter on 16.07.2026 for counter-affidavit.
