If there are no warrants pending against the petitioners, the appearance of petitioners before the trial Court is dispensed with whenever their presence is not required subject to the condition that the petitioners are being represented by their counsel on every date of hearing and in case of non-appearance of the petitioners on the specific date so fixed by the trial Court for appearance, this order gets vacated automatically.

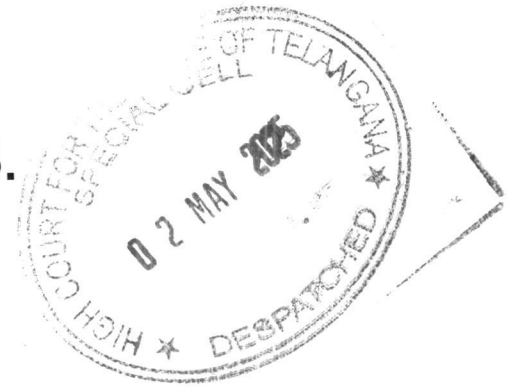
