WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate M/s. KAMPALLI UDAY KANTH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 4th Respondent in seizing the Petitioner's goods vehicle bearing No. AP 07TH 5019, pursuant to Vehicle Check Report No. 429556 dated 17.04.2026, as illegal, arbitrary, and unconstitutional, being violative of Article 19(1)(g) of the Constitution of India and consequently direct Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to forthwith release the said vehicle upon collection of the applicable compounding amount as prescribed under Section 200(1) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and AFFIDAVIT filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/s. KAMPALLI UDAY KANTH Advocate for the Petitioner and Assistant Government Pleader for Transport for respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
