Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents, more particularly the Respondent No.3, in conducting the survey of the patta lands of the petitioners in respect of land bearing Survey Nos.399, 400 and 401 situated at Venkayapalli H/o. Pothireddypally Village, Thimmajipeta Mandal, Nagarkurnool District without issuing mandatory notice to the petitioners as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, unconstitutional, clear violation of Principles of Natural Justice and consequently direct the respondent No.3 to conduct a fresh survey by issuing notices to the petitioners as well as all the interested persons and adjacent land owners in the interest of justice.
