Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring that-a)The action of the Respondents in not paying the retiral and pensionary benefits payable to the Petitioner, in pursuance of the proceedings issued by Respondent No.2 vide Letter Nos. AG(A&E)/P14/IV/P-178/SP457/2024-08/2108, dated 06.09.2024 and AG(A&E)/P14/IV/P-178/SP457/2024-08/4031, dated 12.02.2025, is illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of Articles 14, 16 and 300-A of the Constitution of India b)Consequently, direct the Respondents to forthwith release and disburse all terminal benefits

payable to the Petitioner, aggregating to Rs.37,58,912/- (Rupees Thirty Seven Lakhs Fifty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred and Twelve only), including
Rs.22,04,648/- vide Token No. 2522960925 towards Commutation Share
Rs.8,71,599/- vide Token No. 2522960936 towards Commutation TS
Rs.3,62,665/- vide Token No. 2522960905 towards Gratuity TS
Rs.2,29,334/- vide Token No. 2524179625 towards Gratuity Comp
Rs.90,666/- vide Token No. 2524179641 towards Gratuity TS all in pursuance of the
Petitioners retirement dated 31.08.2024 and the proceedings issued by Respondent
No.2

c)Direct the Respondents to pay interest @ 9 %per annum on the delayed payment
of the aforesaid amounts from the date they became due till the date of actual
realization

ORDER:

Heard Sri Buyyankar Krishna Karthik, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III appearing for the respondents and perused the material on record. With their consent, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner filed the instant Writ Petition questioning the action of the respondents in not releasing the petitioner's retiral

benefits, despite token numbers having already been raised by the respondent authorities for payment of the amounts payable to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the *lis* raised in the present Writ Petition has already been adjudicated by the Division Bench of this Court in W.P.No.23138 of 2025, which was disposed of *vide* order dated 03.09.2025, and thus prayed to pass a similar order in the present Writ Petition also.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III did not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner with regard to the disposal of W.P.No.23138 of 2025 dated 03.09.2025 and submits that the respondents will release the amounts on a priority basis of the token numbers and prayed this Court to pass appropriate orders.

5. Having regard to the above made submissions and for the reasons alike in the order dated 03.09.2025 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.P.No.23138 of 2025, this Writ

Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to ensure that the entire amount payable to the petitioner is released as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six (6) weeks from today, failing which, the entire amount with regard to the retiral benefits shall carry interest at the rate of 10% per annum, from the date the amount fell due, till the actual date of its payment.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

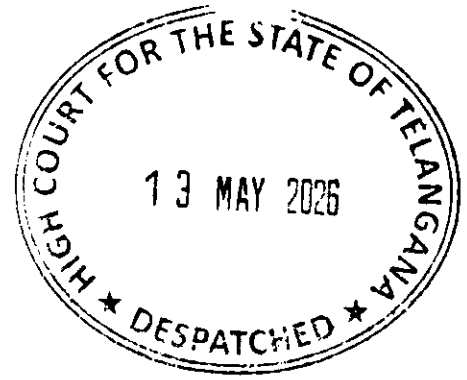
