Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring action of 4th respondent in interfering with petitioner peaceful possession and enjoyment of land in Sy. No. 27 an extent of Ac. 13-06 and in Sy. No. 30 an extent of Ac. 16-29 Gts. totaling an extent of Ac. 29-35 Gts. all situated in Bahadurguda Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District without following due process of law as being illegal, arbitrary and against to principles of natural justice and Art. 300A of the Constitution of India, 1950 and consequently direct 4th respondent not to interfere with petitioner peaceful possession and enjoyment of land in Sy. No. 27 an extent of Ac. 13-06 and in Sy. No. 30 an extent of Ac. 16-29 Gts. totaling an extent of Ac. 29-35 Gts. all situated in Bahadurguda Village, Shamshabad Mandal, Ranga Reddy District without following due process of law.

Mr. L. Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, appearing for the respondents, seeks time to get instructions.

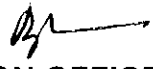
