Mahbubnagar Town- I, Mahbubnagar District.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. HARENDRA PRASAD, Senior Counsel representing Sri. A NAREN RUDRA Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 02.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in F.I.F. No. 85 of 2026, Dated.04-04-2026 on the file of P.S. Mahbubnagar Town-I, Mahbubnagar District, Pending disposal of CRLP No 6191 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Upon perusal of record, it reveals that respondent No.2 has not given full address in the complaint. In view of the same, learned Additional Public Prosecutor is directed to inform the concerned Station House Officer to serve notice to respondent No.2.

Mr. Harendra Prasad, learned Senior Counsel representing Sri A. Naren Rudra, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence, much less the alleged offence, and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Respondent No.2 filed the present complaint only with an intention to dissolve the civil disputes which are pending between the parties before the competent Court. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the ingredients of Sections 74, 75, 79 read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhitha, 2023 are not attracted against the petitioner. The only allegation levelled against the petitioner that the petitioner is supporting the brother-in-law of the *de-facto* complainant, who is none other than the brother of the petitioner. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against him is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 02.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused No.2 in F.I.R.No.85 of 2026 of Mahabubnagar Police Station, Mahabubnagar District.
