Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order/direction or any appropriate writ, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, declaring the action of the Respondents 2 to 5 in withholding Financial Assistance under Rythu Bandhu Scheme to the petitioner land an extent of Ac.01.10 gts in Sy.no.38/AA/2, and an extent of Ac.02.10 gts in Sy.no.37/1/2, (total Ac.03.20 gts) situated at Keshawapur Village, Dameracherla Mandal, Nalgonda District, is illegal, arbitrary contrary to the directions under Rythu Bandhu Scheme and also violation of principles of natural law & justice, consequently direct the respondents to pay the amounts under Rythu Bandhu Scheme to the petitioner, in respect of the petitioner agriculture land an extent an extent of Ac.01.10 gts in Sy.no.38/AA/2, and an extent of Ac.02.10 gts in Sy.no.37/1/2, (total Ac.03.20 gts) situated at Keshawapur Village, Dameracherla Mandal, Nalgonda District, by considering the representation dt.20-01-2026, in the interest of Justice.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to pay the amounts under Rythu Bandhu Scheme to the petitioner, in respect of the petitioner agriculture land an extent an extent of Ac.01.10 gts in Sy.no.38/AA/2, and an

extent of Ac.02.10 gts in Sy.no.37/1/2, (total Ac.03.20 gts) situated at Keshawapur Village, Dameracherla Mandal, Nalgonda District, by considering the representat on dt.20-01-2026, in the interest of Justice, pending disposal of WP No 12990 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI HARI KISHAN KUDIKALA Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR REVENUE appears for the Respondents no. 1 to 3 and GP FOR AGRICULTURE appears for the Respondents no. 4 and 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned counsel for the petitioner furnished a copy of an order dated 01.02.2024 passed in I.A.No.13 of 2024 in O.S.No.38 of 2024 by the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Miryalaguda. The said suit was instituted by the mother of the petitioner, wherein, the learned trial Court has granted *ad interim* injunction order restraining the petitioner herein from alienating the subject property. It is stated that in view of the said injunction order, the respondent authorities are not disbursing rythu barosa/rythu bandhu benefit to the petitioner herein. The petitioner holds pattadar passbook in respect of the land admeasuring Ac.01.10 guntas, in Survey No 38/AA/2, Ac.02.10 guntas in Sy.No.37/1/2 (total Acs.03.20 guntas), situated at Keshawapur Village, Dameracherla Mandal, Nalgonda District, *vide* e-passbook No.T28070051282.

The injunction order was passed restraining the petitioner from alienating the subject property. However, the same does not disentitle the petitioner from receiving rythu bandhu benefit.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to respondent No.3 to 5 to disburse rythu bandhu benefits to the petitioner for the subject property.

The petitioner is directed to implead the plaintiff in the suit as respondent in the writ petition.
